UNAUTHORIZED USE OF PARISH PARKING LOTS BY CONSTRUCTION VEHICLES

Dear Parishioners: You will have noticed that our Parish is surrounded by construction projects. In 2019, Azure Apartments requested the use of our lots for employee parking in exchange for compensation. The request was refused to ensure a ready supply of parking for Parish activities. The City of Ottawa assured us, also in 2019, that the Parish should not be concerned about unauthorized parking by LRT workers and suppliers. Regrettably, neither the Azure nor the LRT Office has taken effective measures to ensure that there would be no unauthorized use of the Parish's parking lots.

Maintenance staff, office staff and I have spent many hours dealing with the unauthorized use of our parking lots over the last year. The lots are viewed as a convenient stopping and parking area for workers and for deliveries to both work sites. Our staff has been subjected to several rude and threatening exchanges.

We have sent formal communications to both the Azure and the LRT Office, advising them that effective May 20, 2021 By-law Services and Ottawa Police Services will be contacted to resolve these abuses. Unauthorized construction vehicles will be ticketed and towed. To prevent further access by these large vehicles, as a further measure, we will be placing temporary fencing to block access to the parking lot from both Woodroffe and Byron. Please enter via Knightsbridge to access our northwest parking lot. Also, beginning May 28th for approximately two weeks, Woodroffe Avenue will be closed between Knightsbridge and Richmond for LRT work. Woodroffe will be open to local traffic only between Carling and Knightsbridge. You may still access our northwest parking lot via the Knightsbridge entrance.

Please note that these measures are not related to planned improvements to the parking lots, which are still a year or more away. Thank you for your continued patience. *Fr. Bosco.*

1) Reflection for the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.: The great feast we celebrate this weekend expresses God's bond



with us (covenant) through the self-giving of God's son, our Lord Jesus Christ. He gives us nothing less than his own Body to nurture and sustain us; and his own Blood, poured out for us and for the life of the world. In receiving his Body and Blood we are grafted onto him as branches to the vine in the power of the Spirit! During this prolonged lockdown, most of our parishioners have spiritual communion. We long for gathering once again to partake of Holy Communion in person!

- 2) Vaccine update: As the availability of vaccines is constantly changing and increasing thankfully, those who are **80+ can now book appointments for the second dose of the vaccine and those 70+ beginning June 14.** For further details regarding your eligibility for a second dose, please visit the Ottawa Public Health website, Ottawapublichealth.ca
- 3) Since April 8, we have been restricted in Church attendance to 10 people which includes me and our custodian couple who do live-streaming and sanitize the Church. This applies also to weddings and funerals. The situation remains after the stay-athome order was lifted on June 2. According to the provincial policy update, attendance at Mass will be increased to 15% as of July 5 (Step 2, the weekend of July 10-11).
- 4) I am live-streaming Mass every day at 9am from Sunday to Saturday for the duration of the lockdown (with the exception of Monday, June 7th). You can participate virtually by going to the parish website and click the red button to access the Mass live or recording afterwards.
- 5) Again, this year, we will have to postpone the Spring Annual General Meeting until sometime before year end when hopefully it will be safe to meet in person.


