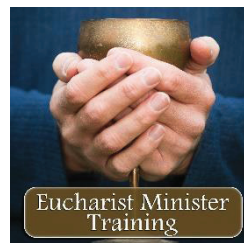

REGARDING BYRON CLOSURE**

Mark Taylor, Deputy Mayor and Councillor for Bay Ward, accepted our Parish's invitation to participate in a community meeting to discuss the closure of Byron Avenue to motor vehicles from Woodroffe to Lockhart. The meeting took place on Thursday, June 8th with more than 80 parishioners attending. Deputy Mayor Taylor confirmed that the decision, made in late January, is final. Feedback from the meeting and from parishioners who were unable to attend is being reviewed and a joint meeting of the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council was held on June 14th to develop a recommendation of an acceptable option to the Archdiocese and provide a formal response to the City of Ottawa. 1) Reflection for the Body and Blood of Christ: Body and Blood of Christ expresses how close and intimate our life is in Christ. The gospel of the living bread in John 6:51-52 reminds us of God's initiative in drawing close to us. If our celebration of the Eucharist is an act of acknowledging our blessing, we are also drawn into it by becoming body and blood for one another, just as Christ has done so for us. By sharing the body and blood we become incorporated into that body, the church.

2) According to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, the Church recommends "that more perfect form of participation in the Mass by which the faithful, after the Priest's Communion, receive the Lord's Body from the same Sacrifice." [#13] We only use the reserved hosts from the tabernacle whenever we run short.

Also, communion under both kinds enables the faithful to participate in a "clearer form of the sacramental sign" [#14]. In our parish, at the 10am Masses on Sundays, we already have the custom of receiving both the host and the cup. We hope to extend it to all the Masses by the First Sunday of Advent. In the meantime, it is appropriate to receive both species also on the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ [the weekend Masses of June 17-18].

3) A slight change will take place beginning the Canada Day Weekend. The Roman Missal requires that we make the brief announcements after the Prayer after Communion, rather than before, as is our current custom. Hopefully the announcements will be rather brief, and we can remain standing until the final blessings.

4) Our thanks to Harry Abbott who has stepped down from the Finance Council after many years of dedicated service. We thank the volunteers who facilitate meetings and discussion with regard to the closure of Byron Avenue. We shall continue to work with the City to ensure fair access and parking.
