1) On Holy Thursday after the post-communion prayer, the assembly will follow the procession to the Parish Hall for



adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. This is in the spirit of recognizing that we commemorate Christ's Paschal Mystery outside of our worship space. The Hall will be prepared and adorned in such a way as to be conducive to prayer and meditation.

- 2) The Easter Triduum celebration marks the summit of our liturgical calendar. Please mark your calendar to participate in this three day celebration which starts with the Last Supper on Holy Thursday at 7:00pm, through the Friday Passion at 3:00pm and a special invitation is offered to all parishioners and their friends to participate in the great Easter Vigil, the central and most beautiful liturgical celebration of the year. We gather on Saturday evening at 8:00pm to bless the paschal fire, to dedicate the paschal candle, to listen to the key stories of God's redemptive love. Please mark this on your calendar and plan to attend this great liturgy.
- **3)** The Passion Readings on Palm Sunday and Good Friday are Gospel readings which require our attentive listening. We have assigned readers who serve the community to proclaim them. The assembly participate by active listening to the Liturgy of the Word.
- 4) Since we only have two people administering the cup at every Mass, it would be important that the assembly will be given both the host and the cup at the beginning of communion on both sides of the altar. We shall have one designated minister to give the Body of Christ to the physically challenged parishioners at the back of the church, keeping the Chalice with the Precious Blood at the front.
- 5) Please come for the solemn Stations of the Cross on Good Friday evening, March 30 at 7pm. As well, you are invited to the Chrism Mass Tuesday evening of Holy Week at 7:30pm at the Cathedral. The diocese will mark the occasion with the jubilarians as main concelebrants. Two of our parishioners will receive the blessed oils consecrated at the Chrism Mass for use in the parish
- **6)** We are having morning prayers on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday at 9am. Please come and pray the Psalms together, the Liturgical Prayer of the Church!
- 7) Please note that Good Friday is an obligatory day of Fast (for those between ages of 14-59) and abstinence.


