Our Lady of Fatima Parish, dedicated to the Mother of God, seeks to fulfill the call of Jesus to "come follow me," to be true worshippers of the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit, and to love one another as Christ has loved us.

1) How do we live our Missionary discipleship? To help us reflect upon our missionary discipleship, I shall



give an hour-long Lenten mission each evening of March 5, 6 and 7, starting at 7pm. The themes of reflection will be focused on Lenten Joy: Mon – Joy of being Christians; Tues – Joy of Christian Families; Wed – Joy of God's Mercy and Forgiveness, followed by communal reconciliation service and individual confession. Come join us for a quiet Lenten reflection!

- 2) Please mark your calendar for the **Lenten Penitential Service** which will take place on the last evening of the Lenten mission on **March 7th.** Fr. Harry McNeil and I will be available for personal reconciliation.
- 3) Why is the ambo normally reserved for the Word of God? The liturgical instruction states: "The dignity of the word of God requires the church to have a place that is suitable for proclamation of the word and is a natural focal point for the people during the liturgy of the word...As a rule the lectern or ambo should be stationary, not simply a movable stand...The readings, responsorial psalm and the Easter Proclamation (Exsultet) are proclaimed from the lectern; it may be used also for the homily... It is better for the commentator, cantor, or choir director not to use the lectern." (272). The liturgical guidelines add this: "The dignity of the ambo requires that only a minister of the word should go up to it." (309).
- 4) The Share Lent campaign for Development and Peace fosters peace in a world often torn by strife and violence. On the Fifth Sunday of Lent, our special donation is for the cause of building peace, especially in areas where people suffer displacement and refugees sought safety and security for their families. Also, we have a special donation for the Holy Land on Good Friday, where there is great suffering for the Christians in the area.
- 5) As we enter into the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, our Gospel readings deal with the Cleansing of the Temple, the Power of the Suffering and Death of the Savior on the Cross, and living our Christian Way of Life comes by way of Dying and Rising. May we draw closer to the Lord during this joyful season of Lent!
