Lenten Reflection:
Today's gospel records the transfiguration of the Lord on the mountain. Peter, John



and James were given a glimpse into Jesus' marvelous life of glory. This life of glory is our destiny as well. In fact, through our celebration of baptism, confirmation and Eucharist, we have already begun to share in this remarkable gift and the annual festival that lies ahead of us draws us ever more deeply into that mystery. Should we not, then, look forward to the feast with great expectation and joy? And should we not prepare ourselves to celebrate the feast with open hearts so that the Lord may work his transforming power in our lives? This week is a good time for us to reflect on the wonderful things that God does in our lives. This kind of reflection will help us all to set aside whatever stands in the way of our transfiguration in Christ. (National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165).

- 2) We still have copies of the pamphlet for the Lent-Easter Liturgical Schedule available at the entrances of the church. This can also be found on our website. Please keep it for your reference. Copies of the Archbishop's Lenten Message are available at the main entrance of the church, as well as the parish website. You can also pick up a copy of a booklet *Lent with the Saints: Wisdom from the Church's Holy Ones*" for personal prayer and medication.
- 3) Next Sunday, March 15 at the 10am Mass, our Elect, Naga Lakshmi, will celebrate the first of three Scrutinies. She will scrutinize her life and seek to purify her intention to follow Christ and be enlightened by the Gospel way of life. At the general intercessions, we will also have our Lenten Renewal. Please support her journey to discipleship with our prayers.
- 4) As we embark upon the Season of Lent, it is good to reflect upon the Role of the Assembly: As a member of the gathered assembly each of us has a role to play. We are called to take part with our whole mind, body and soul. We are called to full, conscious and active participation. We arrive on time, prepared to praise and honour and give thanks to God. Aware that we are part of the body of Christ and not isolated individuals, we show hospitality to one another and are present to each other throughout the liturgy. We sing the songs, with vigor, we listen attentively to the proclamation of the Word and the priest's homily, we observe the moments of prayerful silence and we pray the prayers and responses of the liturgy with conviction. We perform the ritual gestures like the sign of the cross and the sign of peace with care. During the Eucharistic prayer we unite ourselves to the words and actions of the priest. We join in the communion procession and song and receive communion reverently. We do not leave until we are dismissed and our recessional song is completed. Then we remain if possible to visit with other members of the community. We go forth, spiritually recharged to live our lives as followers of Christ. (Celebrate, v.44#2 (2005),. p. 26-27).
- 5) The recent widespread of coronavirus (no case as yet in Ottawa) and flu season compels us to be prudent in frequent hand-washing after shaking hands and avoid sharing the Communion cup if we have flu-like symptoms in consideration for others. We continue to make available Communion in both species, as preferred by the Liturgical Norms of the Church. It is always the personal discretion of parishioners whether to receive from the cup. Should the situation call for greater prudence in preventing the spread of germs, we shall adjust accordingly!
- 6) **Prayers for vocations for 2**nd **Sunday of Lent:** For all priests, who bring us to the mountain of Christ at every Mass and feed us with His transforming love in the sacraments, we pray to the Lord.
