- 1) Our Knights of Columbus Council invites everyone to an appreciation day with lunch after the 11:30am Mass, today, Sunday, March 31st. After lunch I shall share with you a reflection on the recent Sex Abuse Summit in the Vatican, February 21-24.
- 2) During the Season of Lent, our faith community join with Daryl McNiece in this season of renewal in our baptismal commitment. We shall use the Cycle A readings for the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent. Scrutinies will be celebrated for the Elect, so as to strengthen and purify their conviction to follow Christ and turn away from sin.
- 3) What are the scrutinies? Our Elect will make the resolve to scrutinize their lives, turning away from sin and embrace the way of life as followers of Christ, as the baptized are also called to Lenten Renewal during this joyful season as Disciples of Christ.
- 4) We invite parishioners to come and support our Elect at the Easter Vigil: Leah McNiece and Celia Cheung. Please pray for them as they seek to follow Our Lord Jesus Christ in their journey to complete their initiation and live the Christian way of life! Daryl McNiece will also complete his initiation through Confirmation and First Communion. A reception will be held after the Celebration!
- 5) In last week's column in the Ottawa Sun, Archbishop Prendergast wrote about the *Tenebrae* service on Wednesday of Holy Week at Notre Dame Cathedral. In promoting this ancient liturgy, he is calling attention this year to a particular issue. He wishes participants to pray in atonement for *"in particular, the sexual and physical abuse of minors and vulnerable individuals committed by priests and concealed by bishops."* Please note that the Archbishop is *"also inviting priests and parishes in the dioceses of Ottawa and Alexandria-Cornwall to arrange prayers of atonement that might bring about the healing of wounded and broken relationships."* We hope to pray for this prayer of atonement before 9am Mass on April 6 as a gesture that we support victims and recognize our own need for healing.
