1) Sixth Sunday of Easter Reflection – Today's gospel picks up where last Sunday's left off. Jesus talked about his intimate



union with the Father. "I am in the Father and the Father is in me". Now he tells his disciples that, on the day of his return, "you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you". All of this is fulfilled in the Sunday Eucharist, where the Lord shares his life with us, where we share communion of life in God. (National Bulletin Liturgy, vol. 33 #165]

- 2) We are having an anointing of the sick during Mass on Saturday, June 10th at 4:30pm. Our elderly and infirmed parishioners are also welcome to take part in this service. To facilitate our proper understanding of the sacrament of the sick, I would ask you to read this, taken from Pastoral Care of the Sick: Rites of Anointing and Viaticum: General Introduction. Recipients of the Anointing of the Sick: The Letter of James states that the sick are to be anointed in order to raise them up and save them. Great care and concern should be taken to see that those of the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age receive this Sacrament. A prudent or reasonably sure judgment, without scruple, is sufficient for deciding on the seriousness of an illness; if necessary a doctor may be consulted The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious. A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present. Sick children are to be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
- 3) According to the Church's Order, The Rite of Christian Initiation, it is the entire parish community that is responsible for the initiation of new members. We begin the initiation process whenever they come to inquire about becoming Catholics. We embark on a process of discernment, by welcoming and introducing them to different parishioners and helping them discern if the Spirit calls them to become disciples of Christ. Members of the parish play different roles to support them. Please invite those who are not baptized, but are interested in searching for meaning or are attracted to the Christian way of life to contact me or Fr. Tavis.
- 4) Fr. Ross Finlan, Administrator of St. Basil's, Sr. Sheila Finnerty, gsic, an expert of Adult Initiation, and I shall be giving a workshop on Adult Initiation, including the initiation of Children who have reached catechetical age, following the Canonical Norms of the Diocese. This workshop will be held on Saturday, May 27<sup>th</sup> (9:45am-12:30pm). This is an opportunity to see how the entire parish community is involved in the initiation process. There is no charge, all are welcome please contact the Parish Office to pre-register.


