- 1) After seven weeks of Easter which we concluded last Sunday with the Feast of Pentecost, we are back to Ordinary Time with the Feast of the Holy Trinity this Sunday and the Body and Blood of Christ next Sunday. These two feasts are closely connected with God's saving love for us. Holy Trinity: the love of God in communion of Father, Son and Holy Spirit, the outflow of divine love in order to save us and draw us up to share divine life. The Body and Blood of Christ expresses the giving of Christ himself for the life of the world, so that when we receive His Body and Blood, we pledge our commitment to be nourished and strengthened by him, and in turn, **be Bread broken for others and Blood poured out for others – our missionary discipleship.**
- 2) We are looking for new members on the Pastoral Council Please speak to me if you are able to help with this vital service to the parish. We also thank the outgoing members who have completed their term of service.
- 3) At Pentecost last Sunday, we celebrated all those who exercise the gifts that the Holy Spirit bestows upon individuals and the faith community as we live our discipleship. We are having a volunteers' appreciation reception to render thanks and encourage others to come forward to serve the faith community and live their identity as disciples of Christ.
- 4) We have available in the parish library two copies of an important book on Adult Initiation – Diana Macalintal, *Your Parish is the Curriculum: RCIA in the Midst of the Community.* This book helps us to understand our role as Missionary Disciples while welcoming others to join our faith community.
- 5) This Sunday, May 27th at the 11:30am Mass, our parish community celebrates the Rite of Welcoming for Kendra Oatway. She was baptized in another Christian Church, but she has embarked upon the journey in view of becoming a Catholic Christian since last Fall. Her faith journey has taken her to know more about our Catholic tradition, about Jesus through reflection on the gospels, through prayer and by joining us in worship each Sunday. Our faith community will provide witness, we mentor and support her with our prayers during her discernment into the Catholic Christian life. This period will conclude when she is ready to make her profession of faith, celebrate confirmation and first communion, with the help of her sponsor and support of the faith community.
