We want to keep each other safe. Here are some of the changes you can expect:

- You will be asked to <u>please stay home</u> if you exhibit any of the symptoms of flu or COVID19 including fever, sore throat, coughing, sneezing.
- You must wear a mask or face covering when you attend and you are asked to please bring your own sanitizer as well, if possible. Otherwise sanitizer will be available at the entrance & exit doors.

WHY DO I NEED TO SIGN IN AT MASS? Ottawa Public Health requires all places of worship to maintain an attendance log for purposes of contact tracing in case of an outbreak. This is for your protection so that they can contact you if necessary. Please sanitize your hands and look for your LAST NAME on the list, then place a checkmark beside your name. If you cannot find your name please print it on the blank sheet provided, along with your phone number. The usher will then guide you to your seat. Records will be kept private and destroyed after 30 days. Many thanks for your patience and co-operation!

You do not need to register for Mass, however you must provide contact information as per Ottawa Public Health. We do not want to turn anyone away but we are limited to 100 people – please be patient as we move forward. Unfortunately the washroom is only available for emergencies as it needs to be sanitized after each use. We are complying with directives from the Archdiocese and health regulations. Our volunteer ushers will direct you to your seat. Please follow their instructions and do not move from your assigned spot.  Solemnity of All Saints: aside
 from those who are formally
 recognized as saints in the



church, we commemorate all the unknown saints who are icons of holiness and reveal the face of God. May they inspire us to follow their examples!

- 2) November is the month of remembrance. We begin with the Solemnity of All Saints on November 1 (Sunday), followed by the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Day). Prayer in communion with the saints and for the deceased, are part of our practice. The remembrance of the deceased by a Mass intention is a long tradition in our Church. During this month, because of COVID, parishioners can call the office or email us the names of deceased members of their family and friends and we will inscribe them in the memorial book and pray for them at every Mass in November.
- 3) In addition to Remembrance Day on November 11 when we honour those who gave their lives so that we have peace, we shall commemorate all those who had their funerals held at OLF during this year as well as members of our Knights' Council at our weekend Mass on Saturday, November 7 at 4:30pm. For those unable to attend, the Mass will be live-streamed by connecting via the parish website at <a href="https://www.fatimaparish.ca">www.fatimaparish.ca</a>. Please keep the families in your prayers.
- 4) We are grateful for the volunteers who exercise their discipleship during this critical time who assist us so that we can ensure the safety and security of our parishioners. Please wear a personal mask/face cover to protect yourself and others and have available sanitizers. We are in need of more volunteers to relieve and divide responsibilities. If you are in a position to help, please connect with me or the parish office. Thank you!
- 5) Please refrain from singing at this particular time for safety reasons. We shall continue to read the Gloria. Please bear with us by letting the organist provide the music for the weekend Masses.
- 6) Please make an effort to be punctual for Mass as a courtesy to the hospitality ministers so they can participate at Mass without being constantly interrupted bringing you to your seat, do sanitizing and contact tracing. Late comers will have to wait inside the main entrance until the liturgical action, sanitizing and contact tracing is finished, before being seated.
- 7) Archbishop Prendergast has announced that he will retire before the end of the year. He will be succeeded by Archbishop Marcel Damphousse, currently co-adjustor bishop.

Archbishop's weekly message: <u>The Holy Father's Words on Civil Unions.</u> As has happened before, Pope Francis' comments on helping those with same-sex attractions to be treated with compassion and even that gay relationships be recognized civilly have provoked strong reactions pro and con. I encourage you in addressing this matter with the faithful to avoid the extremes of either seeing this as a bold new move (it isn't as he has spoken before on these matters and he isn't changing the Church's teaching on marriage) or as a heretical move (the Church's magisterium is not formulated in sound bites in a documentary). Let's keep the Holy Father in our prayers, along with any who are struggling with his news.
