1) November is the month of Remembrance. We remember in a special way the faithful



departed of our Parish Community by praying for those who have gone before us. We have set up the Book of Remembrance on All Saint's Day, November 1st. Parishioners are encouraged to enter the names of their deceased loved ones whom they wish to be remembered. We have also displayed a list of parishioners who were buried from our parish during this year for your remembrance.

- 2) Initiation of Children (ages 7-13). Sometimes parents choose not to have their child baptized as infants, and request it when the child reaches 7 years old. The diocesan norm is that once the child has reached the age of reason, their formation should follow the pattern of catechumenate. These children should receive baptism, confirmation and first communion together, at the Easter Vigil or another suitable Sunday outside Lent. (See the diocesan norm 1.7)
- 3) The importance of singing is emphasized in the General Instruction of the Roman Missal. In paragraph 40: "every care should be taken that singing by the ministers and the people not be absent in celebrations that occur on Sundays and on Holydays of Obligation." Please join in the singing with the choir. The singing of both the presiding priest and the congregation is indispensable during Sunday Mass.
- **4)** During this month of remembrance we are reminded that the burial of the deceased and the conservation of the cremated ashes must be respectful of our faith in the sanctity of human life and dignity of the human remains. For this reason, the church does not permit the ashes to be kept in a domestic residence, nor can they be divided among family members. A copy of the recent Roman documents is posted on the bulletin board for your reference.
- **5)** I shall be giving a reflection on Cardinal Walter Kasper's book, *Barmherzigkeit*, translated into English with the title: *Mercy The Essence of the Gospel and the Key to Christian Life* on Tuesday, Nov. 22nd at 7pm. This will take place prior to our 8pm Penitential Service in anticipation of the Season of Advent.
