1) During this month of remembrance we are reminded that the burial of the



deceased and the conservation of the cremated ashes must be respectful of our faith in the sanctity of human life and dignity of the human remains. For this reason, the church does not permit the ashes to be kept in a domestic residence, nor can they be divided among family members. A copy of the recent Roman documents is posted on the bulletin board for your reference.

- 2) I shall be giving a reflection on Cardinal Walter Kasper's book, *Mercy The Essence of the Gospel and the Key to Christian Life* on Tuesday, Nov. 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7pm. This will take place prior to our 8pm Penitential Service in anticipation of the Season of Advent.
- 3) Communal Celebration of the Sick Its Meaning & Purpose - The communal celebration of anointing the sick is not only a gift of healing for the sick, but also a sign of commitment for the entire community to show concern and provide support for the sick. This gesture of the community continues Jesus' healing ministry. An important purpose of the celebration is to provide the members of the community who are well a chance to show their care for the sick and suffering. This could be expressed by bringing the sick and shut-in to the church for the anointing, making them feel comfortable for the duration of time in the church, or continuing to pray for them, etc. In this celebration, therefore, not everyone should come to be anointed, even though no one can claim to be totally and completely healthy. We recognize that the sacrament of anointing is intended for those "whose health is seriously impaired by illness or old age." In the communal celebration, the members who are well are there to express their responsibility to care for and support those who are frail or sick. If everyone comes forward for anointing, there will be no one left to exercise the role of care for others. The pastoral practice of waiting till the last moment to anoint the sick, or thinking that the sacrament is administered while the sick person is gasping for the last breath, or understood as a gesture of sending off the dying person at the last moment, distorts the rich meaning of the spiritual healing which the sacrament provides. Instead, the sacrament of anointing lifts up the sick persons, letting them know that the Holy Spirit nurtures them in their suffering, casts away their fear, and that the Christian community supports them with their prayer. Hence, the community needs to understand anointing as a sacrament of healing and an expression of genuine concern for the sick and frail, not the "last rites" for the dying. This year, we will have our "communal celebration of anointing of the sick" on Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup> during the 4:30pm Mass.
