1) We begin a new liturgical year with the 1st Sunday of Advent. It is a time of preparation for the Second



Coming of Christ at the end of time, moving towards the First Coming of Christ – the great Incarnation, when God sends forth the Son to share our human condition and dwell among us. I have prepared a flier highlighting all the liturgical celebrations during the Advent-Christmas Season. You can keep it for handy reference. We have also ordered some pamphlets for you and your family to pray together – "Mercy from the Manger". They are available at the church entrance. As we have a limited number of copies, please only pick up one per family.

- 2) The vestments and liturgical décor follow the liturgical season. Green at Ordinary Time signifies eternal life. White, worn especially at Christmas and Easter, represents purity, divine glory and resurrection. Red recalls the blood of martyrs and fire of the Holy Spirit. Purple, the color of penance, is used during Advent and Lent. Rose can be used on the 3rd Sunday of Advent to show the joy of Jesus' coming.
- 3) Morning and evening prayers are liturgical prayers. As we get into the busy season preparing for Christmas, let us not lose sight of the Advent Season. Please come and join us to pray the Solemn Evening Prayers together on Sun., Dec. 4th at 4:30pm.
- 4) Anointing of the Sick during Mass: Healing the sick is essential to our mission: "Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two...They anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them" (Mark 6:7-13). The sacrament of anointing states: "Are any among you sick? They should call for the elders of the church and have them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord. The prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise them up; and anyone who has committed sins will be forgiven" (James 5:14-15). I encourage the elderly and frail to participate in receiving the Sacrament of the Sick on Sat., Dec. 10th during the 4:30pm Mass, with the community who gather to pray and support them. Should you know of anyone who is shut-in and can benefit by the sacrament, please bring them if you can.
