1) Please pray that the Spirit continue to guide our inquirer, Naga, our catechumens Emily, Leah and Celia, and Daryl, our candidate for full communion. Our catechumens are sent forth after the Liturgy of the Word every weekend to reflect on the Word of God and let the Word transform their lives in their journey of faith. Forming disciples is the vocation of all the baptized. Our goal is to nurture and foster that spirit in our faith community.

2) November is the month of remembrance. We began with the Solemnity of All Saints on Nov. 1, followed by the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). We remember all the veterans who gave their lives to secure our freedom and peace. Prayer in communion with the saints and for the deceased, are part of our practice. The remembrance of the deceased by a Mass intention is a long tradition in our Church. During this month, parishioners can inscribe deceased members of their family and friends in the memorial book which is located near the front below the sanctuary.

3) We thank all those who organized the Community Breakfast last Sunday after all Masses. Many of our parishioners participated and helped with donations to the Britannia Food Pantry.

4) While visiting the children of D. F. J. McDonald School (Ahearn near Ritchie), I encountered a number of parents whose children have not been baptized, but they have difficulty bringing them to church on a regular basis due to transportation problems. I appeal to parishioners living in the Bayshore area to contact the parish office if they are able to provide transportation.

5) Concerns were expressed by the volunteer sacristans that the candles behind the tabernacle are too heavy to be changed and lit. As of the First Sunday of Advent those candles will only be lit for weekend Masses to bring out the importance of Sunday Mass over weekday Masses.

6) Advent is fast approaching. Our Advent Reconciliation will take place on **Thursday, December 6 at 7pm.** Fr. Lester Mendonsa and I shall be available for individual reconciliation.

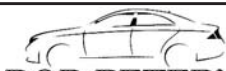
