1) Some people wonder why the extra-ordinary ministers of communion no longer use hand



sanitizer before giving out communion. The handbook of canonical norms gives us the reasons: There is "no rite of hygienic hand washing" before giving communion. Also, using hand sanitizer "leaves an active film on the hands and is then transferred to the consecrated host. This is an unsafe practice as the products are intended for external use only. These products are designed so that they remain active for some time after the initial application." Handwashing or use of hand sanitizer before the liturgy is recommended.

- 2) I am taking a group on a 20-day journey on Feb. 5-25 for a combined pilgrimage to Fatima & Lourdes and classic Portugal, Spain and the Canary Islands cruise and tour including Gibraltar and Casablanca. Next year 2017 will mark the centenary of Our Lady of Fatima apparition. Tour price per person \$4,975+taxes, port fees and gratuity (approx. \$360). - 3) Celebrating the sacraments of initiation (baptism, first communion and confirmation) is the responsibility of the church. Normally, children should be initiated in the parish where they worship, not with the school where the children attend. As more and more children who are in Catholic elementary schools are not baptized Catholics, it is important that we celebrate these sacraments for children who are prepared and supported by the parents as well as the prayerful support of the parish community.
- **4)** Initiation of Children (ages 7-13). Sometimes parents choose not to have their child baptized as infants, and request it when the child reaches 7 years old. The diocesan norm is that once the child has reached the age of reason, their formation should follow the pattern of catechumenate. These children should receive baptism, confirmation and first communion together, at the Easter Vigil or another suitable Sunday outside Lent. (Diocesan norm 1.7)
