1) Liturgy Update: A reminder to parishioners that we continue to have quiet **Adoration** before the Blessed



Sacrament every weekday morning at 8am preceding the 9am Mass. Since the Mass is the source and summit of Christian Life, **Exposition and Benediction** as the fruit of the Mass should flow out of it instead of leading into it (See 2001 document of Pope John Paul II: "Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy. Principles and Guidelines."). However, it is impractical to have Exposition and Benediction after Mass because it is difficult to find volunteer sacristans. Having Exposition and Benediction on First Friday respects the long-standing tradition. Another problem is that we have daily reconciliation and any delay makes it impossible to give Benediction before the crowd walks in for Mass, hardly a reverent manner of acknowledging the real presence of Christ! For those keenly interested in participating at Exposition, we have a Holy Hour every Wednesday afternoon at 1:00pm to pray for vocations.

- 2) While visiting the children of D. F. J. McDonald School (Ahearn near Ritchie), I encountered a number of parents whose children have not been baptized, but they have difficulty bringing them to church on a regular basis because of transportation problems. I appeal to parishioners living in the Bayshore area to contact the parish office if they are able to provide transportation.
- 3) We are having a Memorial Mass on Thursday, November 8th at 7pm for parishioners to commemorate parishioners and Knights of Columbus members who passed to the Lord during this last year. We invite all those who lost a loved one to attend as a gesture of our support, consolation and prayers. Please call the parish office to let us know if the funeral of your loved one did not take place in the church.
- 4) November is the month of remembrance. We begin with the Solemnity of All Saints on November1st, followed by the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). Prayer in communion with the saints and for the deceased is expressed in our Creed for the Communion of the Saints! The remembrance of the deceased by a Mass intention is a long tradition in our Church. During November, parishioners can inscribe deceased members of their family and friends in the memorial book which is located near the front below the sanctuary.
