

Our Lady of Fatima Parish, dedicated to the Mother of God, seeks to fulfill the call of Jesus to "come follow me," to be true worshippers of the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit, and to love one another as Christ has loved us.

1) Fr. Terrence Fournier, Director of the Liturgy Office at the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, will host a workshop here in the



Parish Hall on **Sat. Oct. 28<sup>th</sup> after the 9am Mass until 12:30pm.** He will help us understand the relationship between liturgy and devotion, liturgical and devotional liturgical music. We shall also discuss devotions before weekday Masses, as well as Our Lady of Perpetual Help Devotions, so as to help us better connect our devotions and liturgy. All parishioners are encouraged to take part!

- 2) As the only priest serving the parish, I have had to make some changes in weekday Masses and the Masses at nursing homes. We shall keep the regular weekday morning Masses from Mon. to Sat., but eliminate the Tues. and Thurs. evening 5:30pm Masses, while keeping the 4:30pm Wed. evening Mass. New Orchard Lodge will have Mass on Frist Fridays and Carlingview Retirement Home on the last Tues. of the month. This revised schedule will begin as of Oct.1st.
- 3) We are having **anointing of the sick** during Mass on Sat, Oct. 28<sup>th</sup> at 4:30pm. Our elderly and infirm parishioners are welcome to take part in this service. To facilitate our proper understanding of the Sacrament of the Sick, I would ask you to read this, taken from *Pastoral Care of the Sick: Rites of Anointing and Viaticum*: General Introduction.

Recipients of the Anointing of the Sick: The Letter of James states that the sick are to be anointed in order to raise them up and save them. Great care and concern should be taken to see that those of the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age receive this Sacrament. A prudent or reasonably sure judgment, without scruple, is sufficient for deciding on the seriousness of an illness; if necessary a doctor may be consulted.

The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious. A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present. Sick children are to be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this Sacrament.

4) Many thanks for those who volunteered as extra-ordinary ministers of communion. We are making plans to have a Ministry Fair, part of our effort of implementing the diocesan vision of Missionary Discipleship. There are many opportunities to become involved in the life of our parish community. Stay tuned!


