1) Do you know why at Mass we answer "Amen" and not "Thank you" when the "Body of Christ" is given to us? This is not only because we believe that which we receive is in fact the body of Christ as an article of faith, it is also because we are not merely receiving the "Body of Christ" as a gift, otherwise our answer would be "thank you". What we affirm when we receive the "Body of Christ" is both a gift and a responsibility. St. Augustine stated "we become that which we receive: the Body of Christ". In other words, in receiving the Body of Christ, we become more and more configured to be like Him in our action and disposition – we become the body of Christ, the Church. That is why it is inappropriate for the minister of communion to name the individual before giving him/her the "Body of Christ", by doing so we lose sight of the reality that "in receiving the Body of Christ, we become part of His body, the Church". Our answer to the Body of Christ is "Amen"! We strive to live our baptismal commitment of being the Body of Christ for the life of the world.
