SCHEDULING A MASS INTENTION: If you would like to schedule an intention please mail your request with your offering, or drop it in the Rectory mail slot (front door opposite Funeral Home). Requests can also be made by phone or e-mail. Payment can be made by credit card or cheque. The suggested donation for an announced Mass intention is \$15. If you have already booked an intention but have not yet made your offering please make arrangements to do so before the scheduled date so that you can be sure the intention will be prayed for.

BILL C-7: Euthanasia (MAiD) was legalized on June 2016. From that date until Dec. 31/9, there have been more than 13,500 MAiD deaths in Canada, with more than 5400 in 2019 alone. Bill C-7 expands the law to permit anyone who considers their physical or psychological suffering to be intolerable to qualify for death by lethal injection, even if effective medical treatments for their condition exists. We want to keep each other safe. Here are some of the changes you can expect:

- You will be asked to **please stay home** if you exhibit any of the symptoms of flu or COVID19 including fever, sore throat, coughing, sneezing.
- You must wear a mask or face covering when you attend and you are asked to please bring your own sanitizer as well, if possible. Otherwise sanitizer will be available at the entrance & exit doors.

You do not need to register for Mass, however you must provide contact information as per Ottawa Public Health. We do not want to turn anyone away but we are limited to 100 people – please be patient as we move forward. Unfortunately the washroom is only available for emergencies as it needs to be sanitized after each use. We are complying with directives from the Archdiocese and health regulations. **Our volunteer ushers will direct you to your seat. Please follow their instructions and do not move from your assigned spot.** For a more detailed description of what to expect please check the latest Update for parishioners found on our website.

WHY DO I NEED TO SIGN IN AT MASS? Ottawa Public Health requires all places of worship to maintain an attendance log for purposes of contact tracing in case of an outbreak. **This is for your protection so that they can contact you if necessary.** Please sanitize your hands and look for your LAST NAME on the list, then place a checkmark beside your name. If you cannot find your name please print it on the blank sheet provided, along with your phone number. The usher will then guide you to your seat. Records will be kept private and destroyed after 30 days. Many thanks for your patience and co-operation!

PLEASE ARRIVE BEFORE MASS BEGINS: as a courtesy to the Hospitality Ministers. They have difficulty participating in the Mass if you arrive late or at the last minute, as they need to seat you, do sanitizing and contact tracing. During the Liturgy of the Word you will be asked to wait at the entrance until the liturgical action is finished. Thank you for your co-operation.

BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE: Parishioners are invited to submit the name of their departed loved ones for inclusion in the Book of Remembrance during the month of November. Usually the book is left in the church however this year it will be kept in the Parish Office. You may phone or e-mail the Office at 613-722-7661x2 or info@fatimaparish.ca and we will add the name for you. Rest assured your departed loved ones will be remembered in prayer in a special way next month.

1) **Reflection for the 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time:** The two great commandments of love premise upon our entering into a deeper relationship with God manifested through our care for our neighbours. The Exodus text reinforces how we should treat the least of our brothers and sisters, in response to the fact that we are loved by God!

2) November is the month of remembrance. We begin with the Solemnity of All Saints on November 1 (Sunday), followed by the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls’ Day). Prayer in communion with the saints and for the deceased, is part of our practice. The remembrance of the deceased by a Mass intention is a long tradition in our Church. During this month, because of COVID, parishioners can call the office or email us the names of deceased members of their family and friends and we will inscribe them in the memorial book and pray for them at every Mass in November.

3) We are grateful for the volunteers who exercise their discipleship during this critical time who assist us so that we can ensure the safety and security of our parishioners. Please wear a personal mask/face cover to protect yourself and others and have available sanitizers. **We are in need of more volunteers to relieve and divide responsibilities. If you are in a position to help, please connect with me or the parish office. Thank you!**

4) Please refrain from singing at this particular time for safety reasons. We shall continue to read the Gloria. Please bear with us by letting the organist provide the music for the weekend Masses.

5) Please make an effort to be punctual for Mass as a courtesy to the hospitality ministers so they can participate at Mass without being constantly interrupted bringing you to your seat, do sanitizing and contact tracing. Late comers will have to wait inside the main entrance until the liturgical action, sanitizing and contact tracing is finished, before being seated.
