- 2) Should parishioners have a loved one who is sick or frail, please let me know so that I can anoint him/her with the Sacrament of the Sick. It is better to administer the sacrament to them while they are responsive to the prayers so that they can obtain consolation and support through the sacrament. It is easier to give them the sacrament of the sick before they get into hospital, simply call me and make the arrangement. While the sick are hospitalized, it is easier to call the Chaplain stationed there to administer the Sacrament of the Sick. For further information, do not hesitate to call me or the office for any assistance.
- 3) Many thanks to parishioners who have made donations to the school supplies for our parochial schools: Our Lady of Fatima and Dr. F. J. McDonald. I am very impressed by the generosity of our parishioners every year.
- 4) Parishioners are always encouraged to be involved in ministries and services in the life of the parish community. This is an exercise in discipleship, to serve the needs of our faith community. For example, we shall be extending Holy Communion in both species at all weekend Masses, and we will need more extra-ordinary ministers to make this happen. We also need more hospitality ministers and lectors, so please do not hesitate to connect with the co-ordinators of these ministries.
- 5) If you notice that the sanctuary is a lot brighter, that is because we have changed to LED lights. Instead of having four 500 Watt lights, we now have 2 sets of five 20 Watt LED lights on both sides of the sanctuary. We have also changed to LED lights for the main body of the Church. We should, therefore, make substantial savings on the electrical bill and reduce the heat emitted in the sanctuary area.
