- 1) We are having an anointing service during the 4:30 pm Mass on Sat. September 8. Please refer to the website or the bulletin of the last couple of weeks for details. This is the only occasion in which sacramental oil of anointing should be used. Other healing Masses in which non-sacramental oil (olive oil) can be used for Masses with the "slain of the spirit" or other "healing Masses" which express our need for healing should be differentiated from the Mass with anointing of the sick.
- 2) Parishioners who have a loved one who is sick or frail please let me know so that I can anoint him/her with the sacrament of the sick. It is better to administer the sacrament to them while they are responsive to the prayers so that they can obtain consolation and support through the sacrament. It is easier to give them the sacrament of the sick before they get into hospital. Simply call me and make the arrangement! While the sick are hospitalized, it is easier to call the chaplain stationed there to administer the sacrament of the sick. For further information, do not hesitate to call me or the office for any assistance.
- **3)** Many thanks to parishioners who have made donations to the school supplies for our parochial schools: Our Lady of Fatima and Dr. F. J. MacDonald. I am very impressed by the generosity of our parishioners every year.
