WELCOME BACK TO MASS AS OF JULY 16, 2021 in-person worship is allowed with physical distanced capacity. The Mass is livestreamed Saturdays at 4:30pm - click on the red button on our website. **The Mass schedule is as follows:** Monday-Friday 9am, Saturday 9:00am and 4:30pm, Sunday 8:30am, 10am and 11:30am. There is no need to pre-register.

If you haven't been able to join us in-person for a while, here are some of the changes you can expect to see:

- Entry is by the main double doors, exit as directed by the ushers.
- You must wear a mask or face covering.
- You will be asked to sanitize your hands upon entry and sign in for contact tracing purposes.
- Please wait to be seated. Our friendly volunteers will direct you to your seat. Please remain in the seat you are given.
- If you would like to light a candle, please do so before the start of Mass only.
- The priest or Eucharistic Minister will bring communion to you in the pews.
- Please follow the directions of the ushers at the end of Mass. We must clear the church promptly so that it can be sanitized before the start of the next Mass.
- There is one washroom near the church entrance. It is sanitized at the end of each Mass.

Welcome back! We know these are a lot of changes to process. Don't worry – we will have volunteers to guide you along the way. We are grateful to our fantastic team of volunteers who cheerfully make it possible for us to celebrate Mass together. With your help, we can worship together safely.

UNAUTHORIZED USE OF PARISH PARKING LOTS BY CONSTRUCTION VEHICLES: You will have noticed that our Parish is surrounded by construction projects. Unfortunately we have spent many hours dealing with the unauthorized use of our parking lots over the last year. The lots are viewed as a convenient stopping and parking area for workers and for deliveries to both work sites.

To prevent further access by these large vehicles, we have placed temporary fencing to block access to the parking lot from both Woodroffe and Byron. Please enter via Knightsbridge to access our northwest parking lot.

Do you take ParaTranspo? Please instruct them to enter via Knightsbridge to pick you up at the Lobby entrance (near outdoor statue). If you wait in the Lobby, please do not block the door as people are exiting after Mass.
