1) A session on the Initiation of Adults into our faith community will be held on **Tuesday, Oct. 2nd, 7-8:15pm the Upper Meeting Room.**

We ask all those involved in welcoming adults who want to join the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation to become followers of Christ. Forming disciples is the vocation of all the baptized. Our goal is to nurture and foster that spirit in our faith community.

2) I shall be leading a group of interested travellers and pilgrims to Scotland (Edinburgh, Glasgow and Inverness), then Ireland (Dublin, Belfast, Connemara, Knock, Limerick, Killarney and Galway) for 12 days, 8 cities and 15 meals. 3) Liturgy Update: A reminder to parishioners that we continue to have quiet **Adoration** before the Blessed Sacrament every weekday morning at 8am preceding the 9am Mass. Since the Mass is the source and summit of Christian Life, Exposition and Benediction should flow from the Mass instead of leading into the Mass (See 2001 document of Pope John Paul II: "The Relationship between Liturgy & Popular Piety."). It is impractical to have Exposition and Benediction after Mass because it is difficult to find volunteer sacristans. Having Exposition and Benediction on First Friday respects the long-standing tradition. Another problem is that we have daily reconciliation and any delay makes it impossible to give Benediction before the crowd walks in for Mass, hardly a reverent manner of acknowledging the real presence of Christ!

4) We are blessed to have choirs at every Mass. During the Mass, parishioners are urged to lift up their voices with the choir to give praise to God. Remember singing is praying twice over! It really does not matter how well you sing, but use your voice to thank God! So, do not delegate this task to the choir, and relegate yourselves to be the audience at a concert.

5) For those considering signing up their children for the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation, please remember that sacraments are usually celebrated at the parish where you worship, and not the school they attend. Sacraments are a process of growth in discipleship that happens in the context of the Christian Community. Catholic School facilitates catechesis so that children can be formed as disciples of Christ!
