REGARDING BYRON CLOSURE**

Mark Taylor, Deputy Mayor and Councillor for Bay Ward, accepted our Parish's invitation to participate in a community meeting to discuss the closure of Byron Avenue to motor vehicles from Woodroffe to Lockhart. The meeting took place on June 8th with more than 80 parishioners attending. Deputy Mayor Taylor confirmed that the decision, made in late January, is final. Feedback from the meeting and from parishioners who were unable to attend is being reviewed and a joint meeting of the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council was held on June 14th to develop a recommendation of an acceptable option to the Archdiocese and provide a formal response to the City of Ottawa. 1) We welcome Father Cristopher Parraba who makes a missionary appeal on behalf of the Vincentian Congregation founded in Kerala, India which is modeled after the Congregation of the Mission founded by St. Vincent de Paul.

2) Our parish welcomes all who are unbaptized or baptized in another Christian church and seek full communion with the Catholic Church. Please inform me and we shall begin the process without delay! According to the Order of the Christian Initiation of Adults, initiating new Catholic Christians is the responsibility of all the baptized. Rites are celebrating within the context of the worshipping faith community.

3) I have put a copy of the Ottawa Sun article written by our Archbishop about how to show our care for the cremated remains on the bulletin board at the Main Entrance of the Church. The article is entitled "A Burning Question: Creation raises concerns about how we treat the dead."

4) Should parishioners have a loved one who is sick or frail, please let me know so that I can anoint him/her with the Sacrament of the Sick. It is better to administer the sacrament to them while they are responsive to the prayers so that they can obtain consolation and support through the sacrament. It is easier to give them the sacrament of the sick before they get into hospital, simply call me and make the arrangement. While the sick are hospitalized, it is easier to call the chaplain stationed there to administer the Sacrament of the Sick. For further info do not hesitate to call me or the office for any assistance.

5) Many thanks for parishioners who have donated school supplies for our parochial schools: Our Lady of Fatima and Dr FJ McDonald. I am very impressed by the generosity of our parishioners every year.

6) Parishioners are always encouraged to be involved in ministries and services in the life of the parish community. This is an exercise in discipleship, to serve the needs of our faith community. For example, we shall be extending Holy Communion in both species at all weekend Masses, and we will need more extra-ordinary ministers to make this happen. We also need more hospitality ministers and lectors, so please do not hesitate to connect with the co-ordinators of these ministries.

7) If you notice that the sanctuary is a lot brighter, that is because we have changed to LED lights. Instead of having four 500 Watt lights, we now have five 20 watt LED lights on both sides of the sanctuary. We have also changed to LED lights for the main body of the church. WE should therefore make substantial savings on the electrical bill and reduce the heat emitted in the sanctuary area.

MISSIONARY APPEAL THIS WEEKEND: We are happy to welcome Fr. Cristopher Parraba, a priest from the Diocese of Gumaca in the Philippines. The proceeds of the appeal will go to the Diocesan Evangelization Fund, which is in charge of organizing and forming Basic Ecclesial Communities, training lay leaders, on-going formation, and in some cases the hospitalization of priests, and several pastoral programs.
