HOLY WEEK is like no other week in the Church's liturgical calendar. It is a week of intense emotion. Triduum means "three days." The days from Holy Thursday until Easter Sunday are unique so we call them "the three days," and everyone should know what they mean. Throughout his ministry, Jesus predicted his passion by referring to the "third day." Today we enter that sacred time, outside of time, in which we spend these three days with Christ: to serve, to suffer, to die and to rise. On Monday, April 2, Bishop Fabbro will celebrate the MASS OF CHRISM with the priests of the Diocese of London. At this Mass, the Holy Oils, used in the administration of the Sacraments will be blessed and consecrated. Priests renew their dedication to Christ and their commitment to serve God's people.


