HOLY WEEK 2012

A week of faith, hope and love for the followers of Jesus Christ.



HOLY WEEK is like no other week in the Church's liturgical calendar. It is a week of intense emotion. Triduum means "three days." The days from Holy Thursday until Easter Sunday are unique so we call them "the three days," and everyone should know what they mean. Throughout his ministry, Jesus predicted his passion by referring to the "third day." Today we enter that sacred time, outside of time, in which we spend these three days with Christ: to serve, to suffer, to die and to rise. Will your family be represented at the Liturgies of these Three Days?

On Monday, April 2, Bishop Fabbro will celebrate the **MASS OF CHRISM** with the priests of the Diocese of London. At this Mass, the Holy Oils, used in the administration of the Sacraments will be blessed and consecrated. Priests renew their dedication to Christ and their commitment to serve God's people.

This evening's celebration opens the Triduum with the **MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER**. It commemorates the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood, as well as Jesus' command of love and service. Traditionally this day is known as Maundy Thursday. Thursday of Holy Week is remembered as the time Jesus ate a final meal together with the men who had followed him for so long. Following Holy Communion, the Blessed Sacrament is carried in Solemn Procession to the Altar of Repose. You are invited to spend some time this holy night in prayer and reflection. Adoration will end at 10:00 p.m. *One Mass only at St. Anthony's Harrow.*

 <p>April 6 3:00 p.m. St. Anthony's, Harrow 3:00 p.m. St. John's, Kingsville</p>	<p>On <i>HOLY THURSDAY</i>, Jesus said, "This is my body which will be given up for you." On Good Friday, he did it. The simple, perhaps austere liturgy is filled with joy and hope. Blood red vestments of martyrdom honour the victory, which gives all martyrdom and death its meaning. Good Friday is not a day to wash the car, rake up the leaves, to do the things you have been putting off. <i>It is a day of prayer, fasting and reflecting.</i> Serious Christians will keep the day "Holy". It is holy because it is "Good". Jesus has died for you. How can you die for him today?</p>
 <p>EASTER VIGIL Begins at 7:00 p.m. St. John's ONLY</p>	<p>The <i>EASTER VIGIL</i> is the most important Eucharist of the year. It celebrates our faith in the resurrection, the cornerstone of our belief. Ranking highest among the celebrations of the liturgical year, it should rank highest in the spiritual life of the faithful. Saint Augustine called it the "Mother of All Vigils". Join us for this Solemn Liturgy of our Faith in Jesus Christ at <u>St. John's Church, Kingsville at 7:00 p.m.</u> There is only one Mass celebrated this day. No Mass at St. Anthony's and No Confessions</p>
<p>Easter Sunday April 8</p>  <p>9:00 & 11:00 a.m. at St. Anthony 11:00 a.m. ONLY at St. John</p>	<p>The <i>RESURRECTION</i> of Jesus from the dead demonstrates God's ultimate power over all other forces, including death. By his resurrection, Jesus opens the door of eternity to all believers. Belief in the resurrection is the cornerstone of Christian faith. Today concludes the celebration of the Triduum and begins the great 50 Days. After 40 days of fasting, the Church now celebrates 50 days of feasting. Alleluia! Jesus is Risen! Alleluia!</p>
