THIS: Wednesday, April 5th, 2017 the Sacrament of Penance, Reconciliation, Confession, will be celebrated in our cluster parishes. There is no better way to prepare oneself spiritually than to come before the Lord and seek His mercy and forgiveness.

Let us pray for one another as we come to celebrate and for the priests hearing confessions that day. May the Lord remove any fear we may have and replace it with His mercy and forgiveness.
