


#### **PRAYERS FOR THE SICK**

Seldom does a week pass that we do not receive prayer requests for sick parishioners or friends and relatives. We are happy to remember their intentions in our daily prayer and when I offer Mass, all the sick and homebound are remembered whether we have their name on our list or not. We have a team of "prayer warriors" who are praying constantly for ALL the sick, suffering, homebound and those in our nursing and retirement homes. As of April 10th there are approximately 50plus names on the sick list. In most cases we know the majority of those but many are unknown to us. When a name is called in, we ask who is submitting the name and their relationship. Some names have been on the list for close to a year and a number have been either called home to heaven or have recuperated and are back to a more healthy condition. Beginning this week, we will remove the names of those whom we have no information as to their condition. We will continue to remember all the sick of the parish and especially those in grave danger of death or undergoing treatment for life-threatening disease. Please continue to request prayers for your sick and those struggling with serious diseases. We will keep their name on the list for 3 months and then remove them unless we hear otherwise. Please remember due to the Privacy of Information Act we cannot publicize anyone's name unless their permission is given to us by them or a relative. We ask your prayers for Christ's healing of all in mind, body and spirit.


