

FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

This Sunday's liturgy reveals Gods' reconciling love through contrasts. "Once you were darkness, but now in the Lord you are light." In a few days, our whole diocese will have opportunity to celebrate the revealing light of Christ. That light awakens us, calls us to let go of all that hinders relationship with God and one another. God desires to lift the veil from our eyes, to help us see the way our personal and societal choices cause division, oppression, distrust. As we travail this dark valley, we cry out with Psalm 23 for the shepherd to lead us in right paths, to be present, to comfort us, to open our eyes to the revelation of God's glory. In three days the whole Diocese of London will have opportunity to receive God's reconciling glory. Perhaps this is the occasion to let the shepherd lead you home, through your dark valley into the light. In our parishes the schedule for this "all-day confessions" event is as follows: Wednesday, April 6th:

GOSPEL REFLECTION John 4, 5-42

John's story of the man born blind weaves together the themes of light, sight, and insight. Jesus heals the man so that He can see. However, the Pharisees remain blind because they refuse to see who Jesus really is. They are more concerned about the Sabbath laws than they are about a fellow human being in need. The blind man gains not only His sight but also insight. When Jesus identifies Himself as the Son of Man, a title for the Messiah, the man says, "I do believe, Lord." And He worships Jesus. As we worship Jesus in the Eucharist, our eyes are opened to see Christ in others.

Discussion Questions: Who are the "truly blind" people in this Gospel story? How can you keep from going through life "blind" to the reality of Jesus and His love in your life?


