John 6:51-58

Once again Jesus the Teacher is having a hard time getting through to His listeners. They resist His teaching that He is the living bread from heaven. When they continue to object, Jesus assures them that His flesh is real food, and His blood is real drink. If they do not "feed on" Him, they will have no life in them. #### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

John 6:60-69

What a sad day it would be if some of our friends suddenly turned against us because of our religious beliefs. Today's Gospel story relates how many of Jesus' disciples left Him. They could not accept His teaching that He Himself was the Bread of Life. They could not believe that His Body and Blood were the source of eternal life. So they turned their backs on Him and returned to their old way of life. However, when Jesus asked the Twelve if they too would abandon Him, Peter replied, "Master to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." We too at times may find some of Jesus' teachings difficult. When that happens, we speak to Him honestly in prayer and seek His help.
