

The need for our nutritious dehydrated food is only increasing as the world deals with the pandemic. Unfortunately,COVID 19 has forced us to cancel our Annual Spring Fundraiser and our September, Community Poor Boy Luncheon. These are our two main events that we use to promote ourselves, and to raise funds for our operation.




