.ST. ANTHONY HALL DEMOLITION

As indicated earlier, the church hall which has been closed for close to a year by direction of the Diocese, is nearing demolition.

At the time of writing, the diocese is finalizing the steps in preparation for its demolition. Our target date is September 18th/2017 and although we do not have a total figure of the cost, it will be in the neighbourhood of \$50,000 plus. Electrical, plumbing and other disconnections will be extra as will be engineers fees.

Although not at this time, it is planned to fill the open area with a much needed parking lot, albeit small.

We were blessed with a very successful fundraiser for the house, church and chapel roof shingling last fall and hopefully we will be as successful in raising the needed funds for the demolition.

While there is very little to salvage from the building there are a number of church pews that parishioners might be interested in purchasing. Available would be: 3 pews (7 ½ long); 2 pews (18 ½ long): 1 pews (13 ½ long): 1 pew (6 feet long). These pews could be used as deacon benches to place in a hallway or in the basement. The purchaser would be responsible for pick-up and this would have to be done on one set day, as entrance into the hall is closed due to health regulations. This date will be decided upon depending on the number of sales. The cost for the pews as is: short pews: \$175 and long \$250. All monies collected for the sale will go towards the cost of the demolition.

I would ask that all parishioners prayerfully consider making a donation to cover the cost of the demolition. Please make your cheque payable to St. Anthony's parish, and write "**Demolition**" on the outside of the envelope. This is the only way an income tax receipt may be issued either for cheque or cash. Just be sure to include your name and address on the envelope. Any questions? please call the office-733-6591.

CALLED TO ACT IN GOD'S NAME

"Let all the nations praise you!" (Psalm 67:4) to-day's psalm response exclaims. In the psalms and other Hebrew scriptures, this kind of invocation is actually an invitation to God to act, to intervene in human lives in a manner that will cause everyone—not just the Chosen People—to give praise. Stated a bit more strongly, it is something of a "put up or shut up" challenge to God, the sort of strong statement the psalmists of Israel, trusting in their intimate and loving relationship with God, were not afraid to make.

The Gospel has its own exclamation, announcing the appearance of the Canaanite woman with "Behold!" (Matthew 15:22) "Behold!" is a scriptural flag that tells us that God is about to act or announce something through an individual or a situation. In the case of Jesus, God was going to act through this woman, whom nobody among Jesus' followers would have believed to be an agent of the divine will. Like the psalmists, we might passively inform or perhaps even actively challenge God to do something so that everyone will come to belief, but God will always turn the tables on us. It becomes our calling, our duty (as it was for Jesus) to behold the situations and persons of our daily lives so that God can act through us, so the Kingdom can be announced through our living.
