**SEPT. 1st-GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Have you noticed how often Jesus talks about parties and dinners? He wants us to be prepared for that great feast that is the fullness of God's reign. In today's Gospel, Jesus prepares us with some good advice about ways to be a guest and ways to be a host. As God's guests in this world, we should act humbly and remember that we are always in the presence of someone greater than we are. As hosts of God's people, we should offer hospitality to those who cannot reward us. In the custom of his time and place, Jesus exaggerates to make a point. We do not have to leave out our friends and families, but neither should we leave out the poor and disabled.
