

GOSPEL REFLECTION John 6:24-35

In today's Gospel, Jesus does what He often did as He taught people. He moves them to ever deeper levels of understanding. They had eaten the loaves that Jesus had miraculously multiplied. Now Jesus invites them to consider the "food which endures to eternal life." Finally, Jesus tells them, "I am the bread of life." This bread, then, is the bread they need in order to be able to "work the works of God." We can move to deeper understanding with Jesus too. Consider the food we eat and how, ultimately, every morsel is a gift from God. As food nourishes our bodies for our life and work, so the Bread of Life strengthens us to do God's work. **Discussion Questions: The people in today's**

GOSPEL REFLECTION John 6:41-51

When a teacher introduces a completely new idea, students sometimes resist it. They may complain "I don't get it. It doesn't make sense to me." When Jesus began teaching the Jews that He Himself was the "bread that came down from heaven", they muttered and murmured in complaint. They thought they knew who Jesus was. But Jesus responds by promising them that if they eat the living bread, they will live forever. He will give His flesh for the life of the world.

In the Eucharist, we experience the truth of Jesus' promise. We receive the living bread and know that we shall live forever.

Discussion Questions: What are some of the ways we can prepare to celebrate Eucharist so that we experience this Sacrament more fully? How can we help other Catholics who may be staying away from Mass for any reason?
