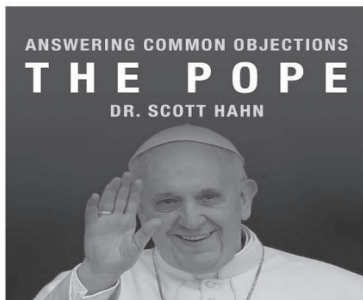

The 106th World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR) will be celebrated on Sunday 27 September. With the title "**Like Jesus Christ, forced to flee**", Pope Francis urges us this year to discover the reality of internally displaced people more deeply. Every month, a new video of Pope Francis and other multimedia materials delve into the sub-themes present in the Message of the Holy Father. The first sub-theme was "*To know in order to understand*" and the second one was "*To be close in order to serve*". The third sub-theme is "*To learn in order to be reconciled*". It offers the real-life testimony of an internally displaced person that explains how teamwork and mutual acceptance can create a brighter future and peaceful coexistence between people of different religions.

These are our two main events that we use to promote ourselves, and to raise funds for our operation.
