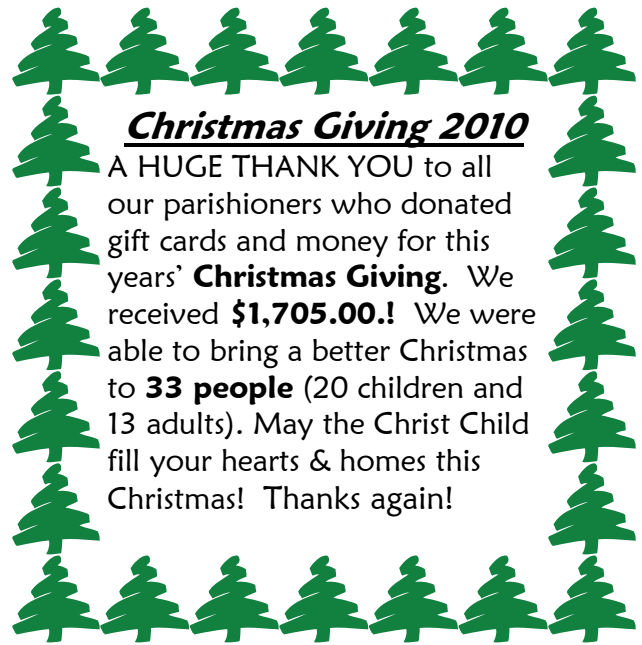


Alleluia, Alleluia. Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths: all flesh shall see the salvation of God. **Alleluia.**



HALFWAY THROUGH ADVENT.....have I missed it?

It's halfway through Advent and I'm not sure what happened. I wanted to make this a reflective and calm season, preparing for your birth, but it's busy and I'm distracted and sometimes short-tempered. **Where are you in THAT?** Patience is synonymous with faith. To have patience is to have faith.. in ourselves, in our fellow humans and in life in general. In the same way, when we are working on a project we have faith it will work out, there are times when we give up, we lose faith, we lose patience with ourselves and others. It is hard to be patient.... ..yet, if we look at the reasons for our impatience, they always show dissatisfaction with the present. While that in itself is not necessarily bad—after all, it is good to have a vision of a better life for ourselves but to do so at the “cost” of not living and loving the life we now have is a great loss. Another instance where patience is lacking is when dealing with our fellow human beings. We get impatient because someone is “slow”, “stupid”, doesn't do things the way we think they should be done. We let our impatience turn into judgment and anger and we create mini-wars within our families, workplaces, parishes etc. Our impatience causes a division between ourselves and others. Yet if we had patience (faith) we would see these things are transitory. Losing patience with ourselves and others doesn't help at all. It places us in the position of adversary rather than friend. It places us in the position of judge and jury, rather than a source of support. **It creates a wall of division, rather than providing a light to make the way easier. We can't change anyone else—only ourselves. The more we become accepting of others, the more loving we become, the less judgmental and critical. Dear Lord, help me to see you in others this Advent season and fill me with your love & patience and acceptance. Help me find it in my heart to call out “Come, Lord Jesus” in the remaining days of this holy season and to treat others with love. Amen.**
