

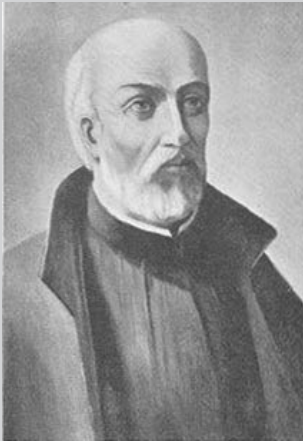

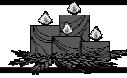

CONFESSION AND YEAR OF MERCY

When was the last time you celebrated the forgiveness and mercy of God in the Sacrament of Reconciliation? For some, last Advent or Lent, others, perhaps you cannot remember. This Tuesday, December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, will begin the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy, proclaimed by Pope Francis as announced in his document "**IN THE FACE OF MERCY**". There he states that God's mercy is the very foundation of the Church's life, her preaching and pastoral activity. If our message is to be credible, we must live and testify to mercy. In our families, parishes, and communities, "wherever there are Christians, everyone should find as oasis of mercy".

If we receive a positive response to the possibility of sponsoring a refugee family, we will need many volunteers to assist with settlement of our refugee family during the sponsorship period of 1 year.

Settlement support to a refugee family includes:

- Orienting them to life in Canada (taking them to the grocery store, appointments, etc.)
- Arranging temporary accommodation/helping them find permanent accommodation
- Applying for Interim Federal Health Program
- Applying for Health Card
- Enrolling children in school
- Enrolling family members in English classes
- Assisting the family in finding doctor, dentist and other health services
- Applying for Social Insurance Number
- Assisting in job search
- Opening a bank account
- Providing emotional and moral support
