GOSPEL REFLECTION

Luke 5:1-11

We can be sure that Peter remembered the scene in today's Gospel as clearly as Isaiah recalled his own vision of God. Even though Simon is convinced that there are no fish available, he tells Jesus, "At your command, I will lower the nets." His trust is rewarded not only by a huge catch of fish, but by Jesus' call to become a disciple. Peter, James, and John, overwhelmed by the presence of Jesus, drop everything and follow Him.

Discussion Questions: For Peter, this catch was a wonderful surprise. He was so overwhelmed that he said to Jesus, "This is too much! I shouldn't be hanging around with someone like you!" When have you been wonderfully surprised by God? How did you feel? You are a disciple, How can you "leave everything" to follow Jesus in prayer and service this week?

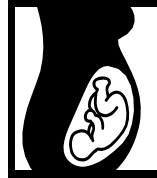
