

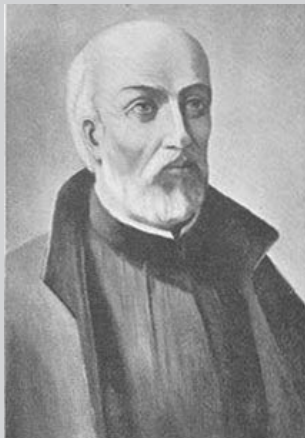

**Keep Connected Parent/teen Workshop
St. Michael's Parish Hall- Leamington**

It's easy for families to get disconnected as kids grow and other demands pull families apart. The Keep Connected program provides an opportunity to draw families back together and give them skills to use over the coming years. Centering Prayer facilitates the movement from more active modes of prayer – verbal, mental or affective prayer – into more receptive prayer of 'resting in God'.
