GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 5

Today's Gospel from Matthew is one of the most intense accounts of the way Jesus changed things. "You have heard it said" He begins each part of His teaching and then goes on to say, "But I say to you." He does what He said He would do—not abolishing the laws of God—but fulfilling them. He never says, "You have heard it said "You shall not kill" but I say it's okay. "On the contrary, Jesus' teaching requires more—don't be angry or name-call. In fact, Jesus says, if you are going to offer your gift at the altar and remember that your brother or sister has anything against you, leave the gift and go to be reconciled. We are called to keep the commandments, of course, but we are called to more.

Discussion Questions: *Which of Jesus' teachings in today's Gospel do you find most difficult? It is a great compliment to be called "a person of his/her word". What "yes" that God asks is most challenging for you? What "no" that God asks is easiest for you?*
