GOSPEL REFLECTION-Feb. 20

Matthew 5:38-48

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus continues His teaching that expands the law. He continues the "You have heard it said, but I say motif and calls us beyond any idea of revenge and to love—not only our neighbor—but our enemies. In our world today, where there are wars and acts of terrorism and acts of violence toward the vulnerable, whom do we consider our enemies? Some would name our opponents in wars, some would say terrorists, some are naming immigrants as the enemy. It is easy to love those who love us, but Jesus asks us to do so much more! In fact, He asks us to be perfect.

Discussion Questions: Have you ever experienced persecution? What did you learn? Is there anyone who would name you the enemy? Can you change that?
