Exciting news about the Refugee Sponsorship:

- Due to the great success of our fundraising campaign for the Syrian Refugee Sponsorship we have been given the opportunity to help some families from at risk minority groups who would normally fall through the cracks of the government assisted sponsorship program (BVOR).
- We have been matched to a family which includes a husband and wife and 2 of their young adult daughters who are currently living in Lebanon, but are lacking the support that typical refugees living in a refugee camp receive. They must still pass through 3 levels of government screening to qualify for sponsorship.
- Because of this family's minority status they are not able to live in a refugee camp and are at higher risk of danger and are not able to register with the United Nations to be sponsored through typical means. Since our community was so generous in supporting the campaign it has allowed us to request to be matched to a second family that will also fit into the "most at risk" category of refugees who would normally be passed over. Thanks to all in our community who continue to support us. We will be making a huge difference in the lives of some people who are currently in a terrible situation.

SHARE LENT PILGRIMAGE



Working to end inequality in Paraguay. This week our pilgrimage travels to Paraguay where we meet Liz Benitez. Her country is one where 1% of the landowners hold 77% of arable land. Liz's family are part of a peasant movement supported by Development and Peace who work to gain access to land for the poorest farmers in the country, *the campesinos*. They have been threatened by the state and police because of their work. "I just want to live peacefully with my family," she says.
