

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

*Matthew* 5:38-48

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus continues His teaching that expands the law. He continues the "You have heard it said, but I say" motif and calls us beyond any idea of revenge and to love—not only our neighbour—but our enemies. In our world today, where there are wars and acts of terrorism and acts of violence toward the vulnerable, whom do we consider our enemies? Some would name our opponents in wars; some would say terrorists; some are naming immigrants as the enemy. It is easy to love those who love us, but Jesus asks us to do so much more! In fact, He asks us to be perfect.

Discussion Questions: Have you ever experienced persecution? What did you learn? Whom do you name as enemy and how can you love that enemy? Is there anyone who would name you the enemy? Can you change that?

**EVANGELII GAUDIUM** - THE JOY OF THE GOSPEL by Pope Francis (Mission-March 29th-April 2st) "The joy of the gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus. Those who accept his offer of salvation are set free from sin, sorrow, inner emptiness and loneliness. With Christ joy is constantly born anew." In his first Apostolic Exhortation released November 26, 2013, Pope Francis wishes "to encourage the Christian faithful to embark upon a new chapter of evangelization marked by this joy, while pointing out new paths for the Church's journey in years to come."

The main chapters of the Exhortation are on the following themes:
