

9-11am, 1-5pm, 7-8:30pm at both parishes.




2nd SUNDAY OF LENT

GOSPEL REFLECTION Luke 9:28b-36

Wouldn't it be wonderful to see your best friend transformed, or turned into his or her glorified self, right before your eyes? That's the kind of experience Peter, James and John have in today's gospel. While they are up on a mountain with Jesus, they have a splendid vision of him in his glorified body. They see him talking with Moses and Elijah, two long-dead figures from the Old Testament. Moses represents the Law, while Elija represents the prophets. In Jesus, both find the fulfillment of God's plan of salvation. **Discussion Questions for Gospel:** The disciples are awed when the voice of God confirms Jesus' identity:

"This is my Son, my Chosen One." How will you honor Jesus as the Chosen One of God during Lent?

Three traditional ways are: daily praver, fasting and sharing with the poor (almsgiving). How can you include these three Lenten practices into your daily life?
