Call to Family, Community and Participation

There was no needy person among them, for those who owned property or houses would sell them, bring the proceeds of the sale, and put them at the feet of the apostles, and they were distributed to each according to need. (Acts 4:34-35)

We believe people have a right and duty to participate in society, seeking together the common good and well-being of all, especially the poor and vulnerable. (Sharing Catholic Social Teaching)

1. What social and cultural forces hurt family life? What forces strengthen family life?
2. What can we do to ensure that poor and marginalized people have a voice in matters affecting them and their communities?
3. How is the trend toward privatization and profit affecting society? (Privatization of healthcare, prisons, water supplies, etc.)



Last week we began Season Four of Arise; **Session One—Life Choices** ~ with our themes of forgiveness and reconciliation. The focus for this session was Lent: a time to review our life choices and to measure them against Scripture, a time to get in touch with who we really are, and who we are called to be, a time to review our relationship with the world, with others and with God. We are invited to build a deeper relationship with God, through prayer, going to Confession, meditating on the daily readings or just taking time out for you and the Lord. A time to be still, to think...to listen.

**GOSPEL REFLECTION Luke 9:28b-36**

Wouldn't it be wonderful to see your best friend transformed, or turned into his or her glorified self, right before your eyes? That's the kind of experience Peter, James and John have in today's gospel. While they are up on a mountain with Jesus, they have a splendid vision of him in his glorified body. They see him talking with Moses and Elijah, two long-dead figures from the Old Testament. Moses represents the Law, while Elija represents the prophets. In Jesus, both find the fulfillment of God's plan of salvation.

Discussion Questions for Gospel: *The disciples are awed when the voice of God confirms Jesus' identity: "This is my Son, my Chosen One." How will you honor Jesus as the Chosen One of God during Lent?*

Three traditional ways are: **daily prayer, fasting and sharing with the poor (almsgiving)**. How can you include these three Lenten practices into your daily life?
