

What's this mean?

...was crucified, died and was buried: <u>He descended into hell</u>; on the third day he rose again from the dead...

"He descended into hell" is the most striking change in the wording of the Apostles and Nicene Creed in the new Roman Missal. The phrase is the original terminology the Church used. The term "hell" is a translation of the Hebrew word "Sheol," which was believed to be the place that the dead went to after their life on earth. The early church's reference to Jesus' descent into hell was not understood that he experienced separation from God that those who have been damned experienced but rather that he truly died, and experienced our death. He went to the place of the dead after His crucifixion, in order to free the just who had died, and were waiting the deliverance of the Saviour. I hope this helps! ~fx. Rick

Arise Update

This year we have 103 adults participating in Arise along with 10 kids. This season our groups include a group geared to teens and a group in Portuguese.
