

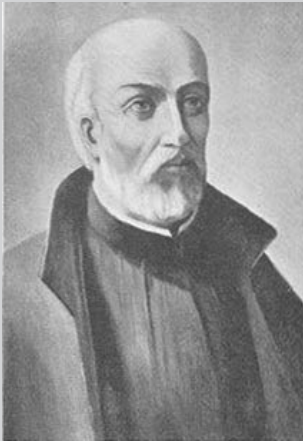

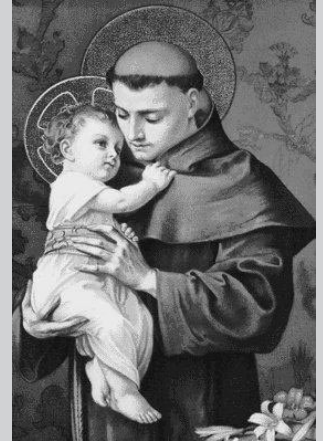

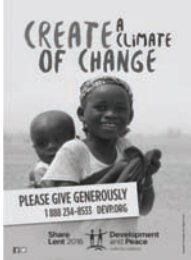
HELP WANTED FOR SSVP 2016 TAX CLINICS

INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER AND AWARENESS AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING- THIS MONDAY: **FEBRUARY 8, 2016**

*In response to the plea of Pope Francis, **THIS Monday, Feb. 8th** will be an international day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking.* Human trafficking involves the recruitment, transportation, harbouring and or exercising control, direction or influence over the movements of a person in order to exploit that person, typically through sexual exploitation or forced labour. **At any given time, 2.45 million people are being trafficked (Gov. of Canada).** This day will be celebrated in all dioceses and schools worldwide. **It is the Feast Day of St. Josephine Bakhita, a Sudanese slave, freed, who became a Canossian nun and was declared a Saint in 2000.**
