



INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER AND AWARENESS AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING-THIS MONDAY: <u>FEBRU</u>ARY 8, 2016

In response to the plea of Pope Francis, THIS Monday, Feb. 8th will be an international day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking. Human trafficking involves the recruitment, transportation, harbouring and or exercising control, direction or influence over the movements of a person in order to exploit that person, typically through sexual exploitation or forced labour. At any given time, 2.45 million people are being trafficked (Gov. of Canada). This day will be celebrated in all dioceses and schools worldwide. It is the Feast Day of St. Josephine Bakhita, a Sudanese slave, freed, who became a Canossian nun and was declared a Saint in 2000.
