

GOSPEL REFLECTION Matthew 5:13-16

Imagine a hamburger with nothing on it but some salt that proved to be chemically impure and tasteless. Imagine a house at midnight with one lamp, and that lamp is covered by a basket. Finally, imagine a disciple of Jesus who either does no good at all or hides his or her good deeds. In each example, something crucial is missing. Jesus insists that our light must shine before others. He wants us to bring the brightness and flavor of God's word into our world.

Discussion Questions: There is a saying, "Charity begins at home, but it doesn't end there." It's wonderful to be good to those at home, and to others who love us. But what is Jesus asking us to do here? How can you and your family take the light of goodness and bring it out to your town, your world?
