

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 3:13-17

Why did Jesus insist that John baptize Him in the Jordan River? Jesus had no sin to be washed away, no need to repent. But Jesus had a great need to cooperate with God's plan for salvation. And that plan required that He identify totally with the people He had come to save.

Discussion Questions: In a very real way, John was right. However, Jesus only says, "Give in for now." Jesus had a bigger plan in mind, and He was asking John to cooperate by laying aside His own way of thinking "for now". Does God ever ask you to "give in" on smaller issues? What is your response? How do you decide whether to "give in" or not? When is it important for you to be "right" and when can you lay aside your own way of thinking in order to let God's bigger plan unfold?
