GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 4:12-17

Once again the Gospel focuses on Jesus as the Promised One of the Old Testament. Jesus began His preaching in Galilee and is identified by Matthew as "the great light" foretold by Isaiah. Jesus' first message to God's people is a powerful one. He says that we should reform our lives, or repent, for "the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Discussion Questions: A Jewish novelist once began one of his novels with the statement, "Beginnings are hard." To repent means to begin again. When have you made a new beginning? How can you make a new beginning today in some area of your life?

Diocesan Assessment and the Thanksgiving Appeal donations are both exempt from the 15% we pay the Diocese. If monies are donated to the diocesan assessment instead of the regular offertory, 100% of the amount contributed stays in the parish for its own use.

For St. Anthony's we had to take \$14,159.00 from the Regular Offertory to cover the Diocesan Assessment. This \$14,159.00 is subject to the 15% tax assessment owing to the Diocese so it actually cost St. Anthony an additional \$2,123.85 (15% of \$14,159.00) in order to cover the Diocesan Assessment for 2010. **TOTAL AC-**

TUAL COST TO ST. ANTHONY WAS \$27,428.85. If the \$14,159.00 was donated to the Diocesan Assessment/Thanksgiving Appeal instead of the Regular Offertory, it would have saved the parish \$2,123.85. No more donations are needed, only directed to a specific fund eg: Diocesan Assessment.

St. John's had an excess contribution to the Diocesan assessment and therefore it did not cost anything extra
